## 2. Committee Assignments:

MINUTE WARM-UP TIME. Each team will have the use of 6 balls for the warm-up period. <u>Basketballs are not allowed in the locker rooms at any time</u>. Warm-up begins. Balls should be replaced on the rack after both the pre-game and halftime warm-up period.

**9. Rules:** Listed in the Basketball section of the SDHSAA handbook. Please review online.

**10. Seeding:** As per SDHSAA Handbook, Basketball section. Schools must complete scores on-line

immediately following the last regular season game. The Chairman will retrieve the

schedule/seeding form from the SDHSAA web site to determine the pairings.

11. Awards: Champion will be awarded a plaque, Baden game ball, and twenty (20) gold medals.

No other awards are given. Awards ordered through the SDHSAA.

**12. Balls:** Warm-up balls to be provided by the host school and Corn Palace. **The Baden Lexum** 

Elite game ball (provided by the SDHSAA) will be used for all District Tournament

games and will be presented to the District Champion at the conclusion of the

Tournament.

13. Passes: Each team will receive (20) adult and (30) player/stat passes. You must show and have

your pass punched each night or you will have to pay admission.

**14. Bands:** Schools are encouraged to have their band play or provide other music if they host a

game. Bands will not be playing during the district championship game in the Corn

Palace.

15. Cheerleaders: Only varsity cheerleaders and (1) one Mascot is allowed on the floor. All cheerleaders

and Mascots must be listed and named on the program to be allowed on the floor during the games. Cheerleaders and Mascots will be allowed in and hand stamped if they are in

uniform. If they are not in uniform, they must pay to be admitted.

**16. Rosters:** As per SDHSAA Handbook, teams may suit up a maximum of 15 players. The actual 15

players making up the roster may change from game to game, day-to-day, etc.

**TOURNAMENT ROSTERS** must be completed and posted on the SDHSAA web

site no later than Tuesday, Feb. 16, 2016.

17. Uniforms/Baskets: The team on the top of the bracket will wear WHITE and be the HOME team.

The team wearing the **WHITE** jerseys will use the **HOME** player bench (North) in the Corn Palace and use the opposite basket for the first half of the game. The team in the **DARK** jerseys will use the **VISITING** player bench (South) in the

Corn Palace and use the opposite basket the first half.

**20. Profit/Loss:** Shared equally by the schools in District 11B.

21. Fund Raisers: ABSOLUTELY NO FUND RAISERS. NO MEALS.

**22. Radio Cast:** This will be granted by the Chairman upon request.
